Boost your resume and professional portfolio with demonstrated leadership

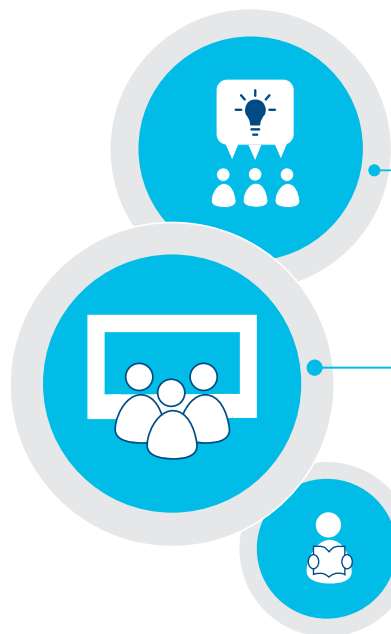


Develop communication skills, your ability to work with others, and how to facilitate group achievement



Program Structure

Duration is two quarters (Winter and Spring), not including the prerequisite of nine Leadership Essentials Workshops.



Group Project

conduct campus-focused group work

Topical Seminars

meet with cohort one evening per week

2021 Schedule

Seminars are held weekly in both Winter and Spring Quarters; group project work is scheduled independently. *Each cohort has a minimum enrollment of 8.*
