A collection of photographs, trinkets and sketches that reflect an individual's goals and dreams for the future/career










Values

Values are beliefs about what is important or desirable

- ■When your values line up with how you live and work, you tend to feel more satisfied and confident
- Living or working in ways that contradict your values can lead to dissatisfaction, confusion, and discouragement


What are the values that you possess as a leader?
